And whereas upon the said Complaint by *Richard Markin* his atty. complains that whereas the said *Blaint* of 19. day of March 1699. at Kent County is in the jurisdiction of this Court at the *Instans* & request of the said *John* had sold & Delivered unto the said *John* divers goods wares & Merchandise and had lent unto the said *John* one bushell of Indian Corn & had done divers Services for the said *John* as appeared by an au. thereof to this Court annexed and here in Court brought amounting to the sum of Three pounds one Shilling & nine pence Not Money in consideration of the said *Blaint* upon himself & upon the said *Blaint* faithfully promised that he the said *John* should pay the said sum of 3:1:9 when thereunto afterward required would well & truly pay the said *Blaint* of 3:1:9 according to his said promise and assumption to pay hath done & paid the said sum of 3:1:9 unto the said *Blaint* altho the said *Blaint* hath not paid but the said *Blaint* doth deny & refuse to pay the said sum of 3:1:9 unto the said *Blaint* Six pounds of like Money therein upon his being thus sued *Markin 1701* *John Doe* *John Roe*
