 in consideration whereof the said Richard Watts upon himself assumed and to the said Nathan  
 faithfully promised that he the said Richard Watts would pay to him the said Nathan  
 when thereunto he should be afterwards required so much as he the said Nathan  
 should therefore reasonably demand and the said Nathan in fact faith that for the said goods  
 wares & merchandises in the said bill of particulars to this Court annexed as aff. he doth  
 reasonably demand to have of James of four hundred ninety & five pounds of £. yet the  
 Richard Watts his promise and assumption aff. little regarding but plotting contriving  
 fraudulently intending the said Nathan in that behalf craftily & subtilly to deceive  
 to fraud the said Nathan of the said sum of £. in the said out. or bill of particulars contained  
 amounting to the said sum of £. 495. of £. to him the said Nathan altho at Wm. Ribbs  
 in Talbot County within the jurisdiction of this Court on the 20. day of Jan. Anno Dom. 1697  
 & often afterwards he hath been thereunto required according to his promise & assumption  
 aff. he hath not paid but the said Nathan to pay he hath altho. there refused and still  
 doth refuse to pay Damage of the said Nathan the sum of eight hundred pounds of £. in  
 and thereupon he brings this Suit

Comt. Kent. Apr. 20. 1697. Then came before us Wm. Frisby Justice  
 for said County & about Nathan. Hynson and made oath that  
 the said out. is a true out. and not partly the way of wit.

And the said Plaintiff by Richard Marklin his att. prays that the said Defendant  
 Watts would come & answer to his said Debt. but the said Defendant notwithstanding by an att.  
 nor in his proper person appearing to defend the said action of the said Plaintiff by  
 his attorney aff. prays Judgment by Default which was granted unto him and  
 therefore it is considered by the Court. that the said Plaintiff Nathan. Hynson do recover  
 from the said Defendant Richard Watts the sum of four hundred ninety & five pounds  
 of £. Debt as aff. & James of four hundred and nine pounds of £. of Suits  
 and the said Richard Watts in merger

Command was given to the Just. of Kent County the 28. Day of June Anno Dom. 1700  
 that he take Thomas Usher alias Diulus Thomas Usher of Kent County Miller if found  
 in your bailiwick to him safe keep so that you have his body before our Justices at a  
 Court to be held for said County the fourth day of August Next. to answer unto  
 James Rae of Gaull County Merchant of Appeal that he render unto him the full & just
