Ret. of said Plaintiff Waller Smith by R. Macklin of said County & Elias King Sher. of
his atty. mous. of Court to J. D. Defend. Thomas Broffigo may put in 200^l.
bail to said action and committed into J. Thos. Custody untill he find 200^l. bail
which was granted unto him and. Ordered therefore that J. Thos. of Kent
County do take into his Custody & said Defend. Thomas Broffigo shd. remain
untill he find 200^l. bail to said action now depending between him & Waller Smith
who was committed accordingly

All which said Day & said Defend. Thomas Broffigo together with John Haasheub Jon. his
Security comes into Court & said Maj. Jn. Haasheub doth acknowledge & said Def.
Thomas Broffigo shall pay Condemnation if cast or else he will do it for him
On which said Day & said Defend. Thomas Broffigo in his proper person appears and
prays shd. be impar. untill next Court which was granted unto him & James
day was given & Plaintiff likewise Macklin of J.
