Among Domt. 1699. Said Edward did present and obtained out of the Court of our  
 King his Majesty & said County a Writ under the Great Seal of Great Britain  
 bearing the name of said County & said Edward to take & receive of said Thomas Burrows  
 found in his bailiwick & him safe keep so that he have his bond before his Majesty  
 Justice at the next Court to be held for said County the fourth day of Jan<sup>y</sup> next  
 ensuing & date of said writ which said writ afterwards that he pay on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of  
 Jan<sup>y</sup> among Domt. 1699. was delivered unto him & said Elias Thorn Thot. of said County  
 in form of right to be executed, by virtue of which writ the said Thot. afterwards that  
 he pay on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup> among Domt. 1699. did take of said Thomas Burrows and him  
 Thomas had in his custody by virtue of the writ as by the return of said writ  
 made in Court appears. yet notwithstanding said Elias being Thot. as aforesaid and  
 not regarding the duty of his said Office nor his oath taken for the due execution of said writ  
 but craftily & suttily contriving and intending to defraud & said Edward of  
 eight hundred forty & two pounds of £. on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> among Domt. 1699  
 at Kent County aforesaid within the jurisdiction of this Court him & said Thomas Burrows at  
 large whether he would to go & escape his said Elias did permit & suffer without  
 his consent and against the will of him & said Edward & said eight hundred  
 forty & two pounds of £. not being paid & satisfied; and said Thomas & said Elias  
 to be paid to said Edw. unknown did and yet with a consent and slyne himself so that  
 said Edw. could not by any process of law find out him & said Thomas taken and showed  
 said Edw. & consent and advantage of recovery of said eight hundred forty & two  
 pounds of £. whereupon said Edward saith that he & work is damaged to him  
 whereupon he brings this Suit.
