All which next Court viz. the 26. Day of November the return of said writ came and the King high Sheriff of said County made return thereof in these words viz. a

On which said Day the said Defendant by Richard Macklin their Att. appeared and prayed thereof to be impaled until the next Court which was granted unto him the same day was given to the Plaintiff likewise. Bathurst for the sum of Ninety hundred thirty five pounds of God. qualified as aff. convenient in Kent or full County yet notwithstanding the said Richard in his life time of the said Ninety hundred thirty five pounds of God. according to the said bill and the said Edward he had not paid altho the said demandd neither did the said Anna when sold after the decease of the said Richard pay the said sum although the said Edward's letters of Administration were to her granted and wither hath the said William and Anna nor either of them since intermarriage paid the said 135. although
