 performed found that Mr. John Hynson carried it by 10 or all votes
 And the said Electors doo yet further proceede some votes for Mr. Charles Hynson
 others for Mr. John Satter & the said Electors on both sides desired a pole which being
 performed found that Mr. Satter carried it by 10 or all votes and all which said
 Delegates being brought into Court by the Sher. signed for each of them Proclamations
 according to the Tenore of the said Writ
