Lagon River and running for no<sup>t</sup> more than four yeares from y<sup>e</sup> ensuing date but your petition<sup>r</sup> having by Misfortune lost my Indentures & said Morgan Browne my Master would make a y<sup>e</sup> petition<sup>r</sup> serve five yeares altho y<sup>e</sup> petition<sup>r</sup> can bring sufficient evidence that my Indentures was for no<sup>t</sup> more than four yeares and y<sup>e</sup> petition<sup>r</sup> therefore desires your worshipps to take it into consideration and y<sup>e</sup> petition<sup>r</sup> as in duty bound shall ever pray  
The which petition being read by the Court duly considered

It was ordered That y<sup>e</sup> said petition<sup>r</sup> Darby Sullivan doo serve his said Master Morgan Browne & Space of four yeares according to Indentures & no longer

Kent County By Right worshipfull & Com<sup>d</sup> of Kent County now sitting  
The humble petition of W<sup>m</sup> & Joan Hags

Humbly sheweth That whereas y<sup>e</sup> Two petition<sup>r</sup>s being left orphans did chafe last Novem<sup>r</sup> Court M<sup>r</sup> Dan<sup>l</sup> Mallikin his wife for their guardians for them until they came of age or day of ma<sup>r</sup>riage whereupon y<sup>e</sup> petition<sup>r</sup>s were thought fitt by y<sup>e</sup> worshipps for to be bound unto y<sup>e</sup> said Dan<sup>l</sup> Mallikin his wife for y<sup>e</sup> learned time following W<sup>m</sup> was bound for seven yeares and Joane was bound for four yeares
