Kent County & Nicholas Floods otherwise called Nicholas Floods of said County Gent
in Maryland was summoned to answer unto Michael Earle one of the attornies of
of this Court according to the writt of the said Court and in compliance of
a plea that he should answer unto him the full summe of six hundred pounds
of good sound Merchantable Tobacco in the said County which he oweth
from him unjustly Detraisse

And whereas upon the said Michael Earle in his proper person in prosecution of the said writt
saith that whereas the said Nicholas on the 27. day of Aug. Anno Domini 1700 in said County
within the jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill or writing obligatory doth demand
his due goods delivered unto him in Court brought whose date is the said day of year did bid
himself of this writt to pay or cause to be paid unto the said Michael Earle the summe of
six hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco in the said County at
or upon the South Bay of October next ensuing the date of the said bill yet notwithstanding
the said Nicholas the said summe of six hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco
of the said bill unto the said Michael he hath not paid although often demanded but the said
he pay he hath done & refused to still doth deny & refuse and unjustly detraisse the
damages of the said Michael Twelve hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco
the said Earle & per persona plene &c. J. Doe

But the said Nicholas Floods comes into Court in his proper person & confesseth
Judgment for the said summe of six hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco
Therefore it is considered by the Court here vizt. this Twelfth day of
June Anno Domini 1701 that the said Michael Earle should recover from
the said Defendant Nicholas Floods as well the summe of six hundred pounds of good
Tobacco as also the summe of two hundred & seventy and one pounds of good
Tobacco of the said Nicholas Floods in Maryland J. Bondall

Command was given to the Sheriff of Kent County on the 28 Day of March Anno Domini
1701 that he take Gabriel & Bryan alias called Gabriel Bryan of Kent County
in the Province of Maryland Taylor if found in his bailiwick & him to keep in
that he have his goods or for his Majesty justly due and to answer unto
Moses Berry Thomas Lane Richard Berry & John Debauldhaugh of a plea that he
should answer unto them the full just summe of nine hundred eighty & two pounds of good
sound Tobacco which he oweth
