And whereupon said Mocijah Borrey Thomas Lane Richard Borrey & John De Bailshaff  
by Richard Macklin their atty. Tith that whereas said Patrick O Bryan 3<sup>rd</sup> day of  
Apr. Anno Dom. 1700 at Kent County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain bill  
or writing obligatory Dated with his Seal as his act & deed delivered & his indent brought  
whose date is 2<sup>nd</sup> day of yeare aff. did bind himself & his heirs &c. to pay or  
cause to be paid unto said Mocijah Borrey Thomas Lane Richard Borrey & John  
De Bailshaffs or either of their heirs &c. the sum of 900<sup>l</sup> or Lawfull atty  
& said Tiths of nine hundred Eighty & Two pounds of good. qualified as aff. on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of  
plantation of said Patrick O Bryan at or upon the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October next ensuing  
the date of said Bill or writing obligatory 90<sup>l</sup> notwithstanding said Patrick  
& Bryan & said Tiths of nine hundred Eighty & Two pounds of good. according to  
& lon. of said bill unto said Mocijah Borrey Thomas Lane Richard Borrey &  
John De Bailshaffs altho off lon demanded or either of them he hath not paid but  
said to pay he hath denyed and refused & unjustly obtain  
to the damage of said Mocijah Borrey Thomas Lane Richard Borrey and John  
De Bailshaff one thousand five & four pounds of like good. and thereupon he brings  
this Tith

But of said Plaintiff by their said atty. acknowledging the Receipt of the Tiths of  
four hundred <sup>ninety</sup> eight pounds of good. and of said Defendant Patrick O Bryan comes  
into Court & in his proper person confesseth the Debt for & bat. being four hundred eighty  
& four pounds of good. & Cost of Tiths and

Therefore it is considered by the Court here viz. 24<sup>th</sup> Day of June Anno Dom. 1701  
that said Plaintiff Mocijah Borrey Thomas Lane Richard Borrey & John  
De Bailshaff do recover from said Defendant Patrick O Bryan as well the Tiths  
of four hundred Eighty & four pounds of good. both upon bat. as also the Tiths of  
two hundred & four pounds of good. Cost of Tiths &c. of said Patrick O Bryan in
