According to Adjournment came Elias King high Sher. of Said County & made return thereof in these words viz. Non est Inventus & Elias King Sher

Command was likewise given to the Sher. of Kent County & Thirteenth day of an-
noy Dom. 1700 That he take Thomas Carman alias dicitur Thomas Harman
of Kent County planter if found in your bailiwick & him safe keep so that he
have his goods at all times & Court to be held for said County to answerants
Borgrine Browne & Comp. of the City of London Merchants of a plea of debt

At which next Court viz. 25. Day of March Annoy Dom. 1701 a day
of the return of said writ came Elias King high Sher. of said County & made
return thereof in these words viz. Sepi corpus & Elias King Sher.

But the said Plaintiffs by Richard Macklin their Att. & moveable
Court & the said Defendant Thomas Carman may find Esst. bail to said
action which was granted unto him Ordered therefore that the said Def.
Thomas Carman do find Esst. bail to this action now depending between
Borgrine Browne & Comp. & the said Thomas Carman and that the Sher.
do take the said Defend. into his custody untill he find Esst. bail to show
to remaine who was committed accordingly In Dowdell

Who was cont. in the Sher. custody untill this next Court and And now here at this
Day viz. 25. Day of June Annoy Dom. 1701 The said Cause being againe called came the
said Plaintiffs by their said Att. as also the said Defendant being brought by the Sher.
And the said Plaintiff by their said Att. moveable againe for Esst. bail to said
Defend. bringe Thomas Walker along with him who become Esst. bail to said action
and oblige himselfe that the said Defendant Thomas Carman shall pay condemnation
if cast or else he will do it for him

After which the said Defend. Thomas Carman come into Court & confessed in
Judgment in his proper person for the said sum five hundred pounds of the
Court of Suits The plaint. Deb. in

Kent & Thomas Carman alias dicitur Thomas Carman of Kent County in the Province
of Maryland planter was summoned to answer unto Borgrine Browne & Comp. of a
plea that he render them the full just sum of five hundred pounds of
good sound Merchandable West India and Casque which to them he oweth from
them he unjustly Detained

And whereupon the said Borgrine Browne & Comp. by Richard Macklin their Att. &
say that whereas the said Thomas Carman & 10 day of May Annoy Dom. 1700 at Kent County
within the jurisdiction of this Court by his certaine bill or writing obligatory sealed with his
seal as his act & deed detained & here into Court brought is his Debt & 4 day years
aff. did owe himselfe his heirs & assigns to pay or cause to be paid unto the said
Borgrine Browne & Comp. the said sum of five hundred pounds of the said sum of
