## House Bills—

- 1—Property tax credit and relief for certain homeowners—Provides real property tax credit program by increasing cigarette tax, and increasing certain inheritance tax rate; general.....9, 19, 24
- 2—Police protection fund—Increases State aid to certain subdivisions by changing per capita amounts, increasing certain tax rates, and providing for collection.....10, 20, 29
- 3—Expenses of the Special Session—Emergency appropriation.....11, 21, 30
- 4—Rent control—Sets new automatic expiration date on certain provisions and provides for certain exceptions.....12, 22
- 5—Corporate income tax—Provides for taxation of certain capital gain excess while excluding net operating loss deduction from taxable income.....13
- 6—Public campaign financing act—Changes certain limits on contributions in certain elections and relates to the Fair Campaign Financing Act in general.....13
- 7—St. Mary's County—Relates to bingo laws in general....15
- 8—Unemployment Insurance—Provides a maximum weekly benefit, determined annually on a certain basis.....15
- 9—Allegany County—Removes fixed maximum interest rate for which Upper Potomac River District certificates of indebtedness may be issued.....16
- 10—Public campaign financing—Repeals tax add-on provisions and provides revenue for Fair Campaign Financing Fund through tax check-offs and contributions.....16
- 11—State cigarette tax—Includes as part of basic cost for purposes of the Unfair Cigarette Sales Tax.....17
- 12—Montgomery County—Authorizes adoption of local vehicle registration fee and provides for collection and administration.....17
