minimum quarantee and providing an incentive grant and providing a supplemental grant; providing a certain inheritance tax rate on every certain amount of clear value of property having a taxable situs in State: deleting from modifications made with respect to the net income of a corporation subtraction of 50 percent of the excess of net long-term capital gain over short-term capital loss (2) the addition of the net operating loss deduction as defined in Section 172 of the Internal Revenue Code: deleting from the modifications made with respect to the net income of an individual taxpayer the addition of the net operating loss as defined in Section 172 of the Internal Revenue Code; changing the date for filing quarterly payments of taxes withheld by employers; increasing the tax on cigarettes; changing the discount and method distributing the revenues from the tax on cigarettes; providing for an appropriation for the 1975 - 1976 fiscal year of the funds necessary for the increased State Aid for Police Protection; relating generally to increasing State Police Protection through imposing an increase in the tax on certain inheritances, adjustments in the definition of net income, advancement of collection of certain withholding taxes, and an increase in the tax on cigarettes.
