(House Bill 666)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Special Mobile Equipment

FOR the purpose of [[allowing the Motor Vehicle Administration to designate vehicles as special mobile equipment; requiring registration of this equipment and display of the registration plates issued for it]] <a href="mailto:making certain changes to the definition of special mobile equipment; requiring the owner or operator of special mobile equipment to display plates issued to the owner or operator; providing fees for registration; correcting certain references and generally relating to special mobile equipment.</a>

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws Section 1-187 and 3-402(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement)

BY adding to

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws Section 3-603.1 and 3-816.1 Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 1-187 and 3-402(a) of Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws

1-187.

- (A) Special mobile equipment means [[every]]  $\underline{A}$  vehicle THAT IS:
- (1) not [designed or] used primarily for [the] HIGHWAY transportation of persons or property [and incidentally];
- (2) operated or moved over [the highways, including farm tractors, road construction or maintenance
