THAT the owner will have available annually in this State for intrastate operations (.): OR

[6.] (6) Any vehicle owned by and in possession of a registered dealer for purpose of sale.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That new Sections 3-603.1 and 3-816.1 be and they are hereby added to Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws

3-603.1.

- (A) THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF [[REGISTERED]] SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT SHALL USE THE SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT PLATES ISSUED TO HIM BY THE ADMINISTRATION ON SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT AND MAY OPERATE CR MOVE THESE VEHICLES ON THE HIGHWAYS IF ONE SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT PLATE IS DISPLAYED ON THE VEHICLE AS SPECIFIED IN § 3-411.
- (B) APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION FOR THE USE OF SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT PLATES SHALL BE MADE TO THE ADMINISTRATION.
- (C) THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT AND ENFORCE THIS SECTION.

3-816.1.

EACH YEAR A FEE OF \$10 SHALL BE PAID FOR EACH REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED TO AN OWNER OR OPERATOR OF SPECIAL MOBILE EOUIPMENT.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
