(c) A Class B license shall authorize the licensee to drive vehicles of a registered gross weight of more than [20,000] 25,000 pounds[,] and any vehicle which the holder of a Class C or D license may drive.

(e) A Class D license shall authorize the licensee to drive any vehicle except (i) combinations of vehicles[,]; (ii) trucks with a registered gross weight of more than [20,000] 25,000 pounds, but not including an uncoupled truck tractor[,]; (iii) buses; and (iv) motorcycles.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 6-102.2(g) of Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(g) Subject to the provisions of this article, nothing in the section shall prevent the holders of Class B, C, or D licenses from operating the types of vehicles which they are licensed to operate and to which is attached a [semitrailer or a trailer as defined in §§
