the same time more than two journeyman barbers for each qualified barber employed. Any barber who desires to train journeymen must first qualify as provided for teachers in barber schools under § [319A] 318 of this subtitle.

Out of the funds coming into the possession of said Board, each member thereof attending the meetings for examination and registration may receive as compensation the sum of ten dollars for each applicant that may examined; and, further, each member may receive compensation a sum to be determined by said Board which shall not exceed twenty-five dollars for each day actually engaged in the necessary duties of his office and traveling expenses of such member incident to attending said meetings of the Board. In addition to any amounts which may be allowed by way of per diem and traveling expenses, as above provided, all hotel and incidental expenses which any member may incur when attending to the necessary duties of his office shall be allowed to such member. Members shall be reimbursed in accordance with the standard travel regulations. All moneys collected under this subtitle shall be paid over to the State Treasurer, and shall become general funds of the State.
