BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 77 — Public Education Section 73A(a) and (b) Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 73A(a) and (b) of Article 77 — Public Education, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1975 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 77 - Public Education

73A.

- (a) (1) The Prince George's County superintendent of schools shall devise an affidavit of disclosure form to be completed AND SIGNED by parents [and] OR guardians OF A STUDENT [enrolling students] in the public schools of Prince George's County[.]:
- (I) WHO IS CURRENTLY ENROLLED OF ATTENDING SCHOOL DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR 1976;
- (II) WHO IS ENTERING THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM; OR
- [[(III) WHO TRANSFERS FROM ONE SCHOOL TO ANOTHER WITHIN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, OR TRANSFERS FROM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL OR FROM JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL TO SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL.]]

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY WHO CHANGES RESIDENCE WITHIN

- (2) By regulation, he shall make completion of an affidavit of disclosure a prerequisite of admission to the public schools, except that parents and guardians who are newly arrived residents shall have 30 days after enrollment, if necessary, to complete such affidavit.
- (b) The purpose of the affidavit of disclosure shall be limited to ascertaining from a parent or guardian [enrolling] OF a student in the public schools his or her legal residence, the duration of his or her residency in Maryland, the registration numbers of motor vehicles owned by a parent or guardian, and his or her driver's permit number and the state, district, or territory which issued it.
