

(5) The office of the sheriff of any county;
or

(6) The police department, bureau or force of any bicounty agency or the University of Maryland; or

(7) The state Aviation Administration police force of the Department of Transportation and the toll facilities police force of the Maryland Transportation Authority; or

(8) The police officers of the Department of Natural Resources[.] ; OR

(9) THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF THE MARYLAND ALCOHOL TAX ENFORCEMENT UNIT, ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO TAX DIVISION.

"Law-enforcement officer" does not include an officer serving in a probationary status except when allegations of brutality in the execution of his duties are made involving an officer who is in a probationary status. The provisions of this subtitle do not apply to persons serving at the pleasure of the police commissioner of Baltimore City.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

(House Bill 1276)

AN ACT concerning

State Employees - Preretirement Counseling

FOR the purpose of requiring all State employees and certain family members of a retiree within the retirement system to be provided with certain preretirement counseling.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 20A be and it is hereby added
