Article 73B - Pensions

ALL STATE EMPLOYEES UNDER THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH A PRERETIREMENT COUNSELING SERVICE REGARDING RETIREMENT BENEFITS. THE COUNSELING ALSO SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO [[ALL]] THE SPOUSE OR MEMBERS OF THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY OF A RETIREE [[OR THE SPOUSE OF A RETIREE]], WITH THE CONSENT OF THE RETIREE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

(b) "Law-enforcement officer" means any person who, in his official capacity, is authorized by law to make arrests and who is a member of one of the following
