closing. [Such permission] PERMISSION shall be evidenced by a suitable license authorized by the board of license commissioners and issued by the clerk of the circuit court[, the]. THE annual fee [therefore being ten dollars (\$10.00)] IS \$10. Any violation of this subsection shall incur the same penalty as a violation for making a sale of alcoholic beverages after hours.

SECTION 2. AND BF IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

(c) (1) Special Feer, wine and liquor license, Class C, which [shall entitle] ENTITLES the holder [thereof] to exercise any of the privileges conferred by [the said] THIS class of license for the use of any person holding a bona fide entertainment conducted by a club, society, or association at the place [therein] described for a period not exceeding seven consecutive
