

Driving on an instruction and examination license unaccompanied.....5 points

Participating in a racing or speed contest on the public highways.....5 points

Driving while ability impaired by consumption of alcohol or drugs or combination of drugs or a combination of drugs and alcohol.....6 points

Turning off lights of a vehicle to avoid identification.....8 points

Failing to stop after accident resulting in damage to attended vehicle or property.....8 points

Failing to stop after accident resulting in damage to unattended vehicle or property.....8 points

Failing to stop after an accident resulting in injury or death of any person.....12 points

Driving after refusal, suspension, cancellation, or revocation.....12 points

Any violation of Part III of this subtitle EXCEPT ~~[[SECTION]] §6-304 OR §6-305~~.....12 points

Homicide or assault committed by means of a vehicle.12 points

Driving in an intoxicated condition or under the influence of an illegally used controlled dangerous substance.....12 points

Any felony involving use of a vehicle.....12 points

Fleeing or attempting to elude a police officer.....12 points

The making of a false affidavit or statement under oath, or falsely certifying to the truth of any fact or information to the Administration under this article or under any law relating to the ownership or operation of motor vehicles.....12 points

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
