certain advisory committees; placing the Interagency Committee on School Construction within the Department for certain purposes and changing the method of selecting the Committee's Executive Director; creating [[Educational Coordinating Councils for Correctional Institutions and]] [[an Educational Coordinating Council for]] Educational Coordinating Councils for Correctional Institutions and Coordinating Councils for Correctional Institutions and providing for their composition and duties; providing for educational programs in these institutions and methods of planning, developing, operating, funding, and monitoring them; defining terms; making style changes; conforming certain provisions relating to the State and optional retirement systems; and relating generally to public and private elementary and secondary education.
