

Transit Administration to provide free transportation to certain persons working in sheltered workshops.

BY adding to

Article 64B - Metropolitan Transit District
Section 31B
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1972 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 31B be and it is hereby added to Article 64B - Metropolitan Transit District, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1972 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 64B - Metropolitan Transit District
31B.

[[THE AUTHORITY MAY ALLOW PERSONS EMPLOYED BY SHELTERED WORKSHOPS FREE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THOSE WORKSHOPS.]] THE MASS TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SHALL ALLOW HANDICAPPED PERSONS EMPLOYED BY SHELTERED WORKSHOPS WHO EARN LESS THAN THE CURRENT MINIMUM WAGE AS DETERMINED BY THE FEDERAL WAGE AND HOURS BOARD FREE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THOSE WORKSHOPS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

CHAPTER 561

(Senate Bill 81)

AN ACT concerning

Racing - Disclosures of Ownership and Transfers of Stock of Licensed Tracks

FOR the purpose of requiring race tracks licensed by the Maryland Racing Commission to [[report periodically all transfers of ownership of the stock of the corporation licensed for conduct of racing in the State.]] maintain certain records of ownership of the stock of licensees; requiring periodic reports of ownership to be made to the Commission; requiring certain reports of transfers of stock of a licensee;
