

SEXUAL PRACTICE WITH AN ANIMAL.

(B) AN INDICTMENT FOR VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS SUFFICIENT IF IT SETS FORTH THAT THE DEFENDANT COMMITTED A CERTAIN UNNATURAL AND PERVERTED SEXUAL PRACTICE WITH AN ANIMAL.

[[(C) A PERSON CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE FINED MORE THAN \$1,000 OR IMPRISONED FOR MORE THAN TEN YEARS OR BOTH.]]

(C) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1000 FOR EACH OFFENSE.]]

(A) IN THIS SUBHEADING, THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "MENTALLY DEFECTIVE" MEANS A VICTIM WHO SUFFERS FROM A MENTAL DISORDER WHICH PERMANENTLY OR TEMPORARILY RENDERS THE VICTIM SUBSTANTIALLY INCAPABLE OF APPRAISING THE NATURE OF HIS OR HER CONDUCT, OR RESISTING THE ACT OF VAGINAL INTERCOURSE, A SEXUAL ACT, OR SEXUAL CONTACT, OR OF COMMUNICATING UNWILLINGNESS TO SUBMIT TO THE ACT OF VAGINAL INTERCOURSE, A SEXUAL ACT, OR SEXUAL CONTACT.

(C) "MENTALLY INCAPACITATED" MEANS A VICTIM WHO, DUE TO THE INFLUENCE OF A DRUG, NARCOTIC OR INTOXICATING SUBSTANCE, OR DUE TO ANY ACT COMMITTED UPON THE VICTIM WITHOUT THE VICTIM'S CONSENT OR AWARENESS, IS RENDERED SUBSTANTIALLY INCAPABLE OF EITHER APPRAISING THE NATURE OF HIS OR HER CONDUCT, OR RESISTING THE ACT OF VAGINAL INTERCOURSE, A SEXUAL ACT, OR SEXUAL CONTACT.

(D) "PHYSICALLY HELPLESS" MEANS (1) A VICTIM WHO IS UNCONSCIOUS; OR (2) A VICTIM WHO DOES NOT CONSENT TO AN ACT OF VAGINAL INTERCOURSE, A SEXUAL ACT, OR SEXUAL CONTACT, AND IS PHYSICALLY UNABLE TO RESIST AN ACT OF VAGINAL INTERCOURSE, A SEXUAL ACT, OR SEXUAL CONTACT OR COMMUNICATE UNWILLINGNESS TO SUBMIT TO AN ACT OF VAGINAL INTERCOURSE, A SEXUAL ACT, OR SEXUAL CONTACT.

(E) "SEXUAL ACT" MEANS CUNNILINGUS, FELLATIO, ANALINGUS, OR ANAL INTERCOURSE, BUT DOES NOT INCLUDE VAGINAL INTERCOURSE. EMISSION OF SEMEN IS NOT REQUIRED. PENETRATION, HOWEVER SLIGHT, IS EVIDENCE OF ANAL INTERCOURSE. SEXUAL ACT ALSO MEANS THE PENETRATION, HOWEVER SLIGHT, BY ANY OBJECT INTO THE GENITAL OR ANAL OPENING OF ANOTHER PERSON'S BODY IF THE PENETRATION CAN BE REASONABLY CONSTRUED AS BEING FOR THE PURPOSES OF SEXUAL AROUSAL OR GRATIFICATION OR FOR ABUSE OF EITHER PARTY AND IF THE PENETRATION IS NOT FOR ACCEPTED MEDICAL PURPOSES.
