CHAPTER 579

(Senate Bill 453)

AN ACT concerning

Farm Vehicles - Classes and Registration Fees

FOR the purpose of ~~[[increasing the gross weight and fees]]~~ adding a new weight class and registration fee for farm straight trucks; providing new classes for farm ~~[[trucks or traction engines]]~~ truck tractors used for propelling or drawing a trailer or semitrailer and the fees for registering based on gross weight; and providing for registration fees for farm trailers and semitrailers based on gross shipping weight.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 3-806(e) of Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws

3-806.

(e) If a Class E vehicle is a single unit truck owned by a farmer and qualified as a farm truck, as those terms are defined hereinbelow, it shall pay a
