issued by an authority to aid in financing a housing project to provide dwelling accommodations for persons of low income shall be conclusively deemed, in any suit, action or proceeding involving the validity or enforceability of such bond or the security therefor, to have been issued for a housing project of such character.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

Article 448 - Housing Cooperation and Aid

6B.

(b) Within the area of operation of the housing authority of Baltimore City, the State public body shall have the powers enumerated in this article to aid and cooperate with the housing authority of Baltimore City in the planning, undertaking, construction or operation of housing or housing projects for persons of eligible income. For purposes of this section, the phrase "persons of eligible income" shall mean persons who
