Commission, or hold any office or position under the Commission, who holds any official relation to any association or corporation engaged in or conducting racing within the State of Maryland, or hold stock or bonds therein, or who has any pecuniary interest therein.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
