CHAPTER 625

(Senate Bill 1078)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Deputy Sheriff's Off-Duty Service

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Washington County to allow a deputy sheriff to perform certain off-duty services, subject to the approval of the sheriff of Washington County; and providing for the payment of a certain fee for those services.

Article — Courts and Judicial Proceedings Section 2-309(w) Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1975 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 2-309 (w) of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings 2-309.

- (w) (1) The Sheriff of Washington County shall receive a salary of \$12,500. He may appoint an office deputy at a salary set by the County Commissioners. He may appoint the following additional employees who shall receive not less than the salaries indicated: two deputies—\$2,400 and \$50 per month each for the use of their automobiles; one secretary—\$1,800; a chief warden of the jail—\$2,400; an assistant warden—\$2,100; an attorney to the Sheriff—\$600; and a cook—\$1,800; additional special deputies—same salary as deputies. Salaries set by this section, except the sheriff's salary are minimum salaries and may be increased from time to time by the County Commissioners.
- (2) IF THE SHERIFF OF WASHINGTON COUNTY APPROVES AFTER CONSIDERING PERSONNEL NEEDS, THE COUNTY
