

OTHERS, TO PURCHASE, OR CONTRACT TO PURCHASE, ANY PRODUCT OR SERVICE OF A HEARING AID DEALER OR FITTER, OR TO REFRAIN FROM DEALING IN THE PRODUCTS OR SERVICES OF COMPETITORS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

CHAPTER 639

(House Bill 191)

AN ACT concerning

Elections - Challengers and Watchers

FOR the purpose of providing that authorized challengers and watchers have the right to enter a polling place one half hour before the opening of the polls, with certain exemptions when this right may be restricted; providing that authorized challengers or watchers have the right to enter and be present at any time when the polls are open and remain until the returns are completed; and relating generally to challengers and watchers at polling places on election days; providing that election judges shall inspect voting machines one half hour before the opening of the polls; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 33 - Election Code
Section 15-3(c) and 16-11(b)
Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 15-3(c) and 16-11(b) of Article 33 - Election Code, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

15-3.

(c) (1) [Such] A challenger or watcher [shall have] HAS the right to [remain in] ENTER the polling place
