- (g) Secretary and deputy secretary of a principal Executive Department of State government;
 - (h) State Senator:
 - (i) Delegate of the House of Delegates;
 - (j) State's Attorney;
- (k) Clerk of the Circuit court for each county, or of a court of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore City;
 - (1) Register of Wills; [and]
 - (m) Sheriff[.]; AND
- (N) MEMBER, SECRETARY, GENERAL COUNSEL, PEOPLE'S COUNSEL, CHIEF ENGINEER, CHIEF AUDITOR, DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION AND CHIEF HEARING EXAMINER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

(House Bill 351)

AN ACT concerning

Merit System - Annual Leave
