Article 19 — Comptroller Section 8A Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 8A be and it is hereby added to Article 19 — Comptroller, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 19 - Comptroller

8A.

[[NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY,]] THE COMPTROLLER MAY TRANSFER STAFF, FUNDS, AND EQUIPMENT FROM ANY OFFICE, DIVISION OR BUREAU WITHIN HIS JURISDICTION TO ANY OTHER OFFICE, DIVISION, OR BUREAU WITHIN HIS JURISDICTION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING THE EFFICIENCY AND ECONOMY OF HIS ADMINISTRATION. WHENEVER STAFF PERSONNEL ARE TRANSFERRED, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL INSURE THAT THOSE STAFF PERSONNEL ARE NOT REDUCED IN CLASS OR GRADE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

(House Bill 679)
