ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY FILE A CIVIL ACTION IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY FOR AN ORDER RESTRAINING FURTHER VIOLATIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, RESTRAINING THE DEFENDANT FROM CONDUCTING ANY FURTHER FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES IN MARYLAND, ENFORCING COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE, AND SUCH OTHER RELIEF AS HE DEEMS APPROPRIATE. AS A CONDITION OF REGISTRATION, EACH CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION, PROFESSIONAL FUND-RAISER COUNSEL, AND PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR SHALL CONSENT IN WRITING TO THE JURISDICTION AND VENUE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY TO GRANT APPROPRIATE RELIEF.

(D) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
