

MASTER PLAN FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES EDUCATION AND TRAINING.

(7) TO COOPERATE WITH THE MARYLAND FIRE AND RESCUE INSTITUTE IN DEVELOPING AND OPERATING A SYSTEM FOR COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS OF EMERGENCY SERVICES EDUCATION AND TRAINING DATA, AND EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION.

(8) TO ENCOURAGE, PROMOTE, AND CONTINUALLY REVIEW RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT IN NEW EMERGENCY SERVICES TECHNIQUES, METHODS, AND PROCEDURES.

(9) TO PROPOSE AND ENCOURAGE IMPROVEMENTS IN EMERGENCY SERVICES EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN ALL SCHOOLS.

(10) TO COOPERATE WITH AND REVIEW MATERIAL FROM OTHER STATES AND FEDERAL AGENCIES ON MATTERS PERTAINING TO EMERGENCY SERVICES EDUCATION AND TRAINING.

(11) TO RECOMMEND TO THE [[SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES]] COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER EDUCATION, SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE REASONABLY NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE TO ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES OF THIS SECTION.

(12) TO REVIEW ANY PROPOSED OR ADOPTED NATIONAL STANDARDS OF CERTIFICATION IN THE EMERGENCY SERVICES AND RECOMMEND TO THE [[SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES]] COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER EDUCATION WHAT ACTIONS SHOULD BE TAKEN REGARDING SUCH STANDARDS OR CERTIFICATION.

(13) TO PREPARE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE COMMISSION'S ACTIVITIES TO THE [[SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES]] COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER EDUCATION, THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

(14) TO PROVIDE A PLACE OF STORAGE FOR THE RECORDS OF THE COMMISSION AND THE ORIGINAL GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION ON FIRE SERVICES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That should Senate Bill 347 and House Bill 971 both fail of enactment, the terms "State Board for Higher Education" and "Commissioner of Higher Education" shall mean "Maryland Council on Higher Education" and "Executive Director of the Maryland Council on Higher Education", respectively.

SECTION [[2]] 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
