SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 37-1 of the Public Local Laws of Garrett County being Article 12 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1971 Edition, as amended) be and it is hereby repealed:

Article 12

[37-1. Movies authorized in Oakland.

Notwithstanding any provision of any Public General or Public Local Law, it shall be lawful to show or exhibit motion pictures in the Town of Oakland in Garrett County on Sundays between the hours of 2:30 o'clock p.m. and 6 o'clock p.m., and after the hour of 9 o'clock p.m., and at no other time during such day, with or without a charge or admission fee, provided, however, that such exhibitions shall be subject to all provisions of law relating to licensing and censorship applicable to motion picture exhibitions on week days. The work or employment of any operator, ticket—seller or other employee or attendant in connection with such exhibition shall not be unlawful because performed on Sunday.
