CHAPTER 742

(House Bill 1236)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicles - Drivers' Licenses and
Special Identification Cards

FOR the purpose of requiring that drivers' licenses [[and special identification cards]] issued by the Motor Vehicle Administration contain a photograph of the person to whom it is issued; generally revising the required information and content of drivers' licenses; [[increasing]] altering the fee for renewal of drivers' licenses [[and special identification cards]]; requiring drivers' licenses [[and special identification cards]] to be valid for a certain period; relating generally to the issuance, expiration and renewal of drivers' licenses [[and special identification cards]]; correcting certain obsolete references; and clarifying language.
