Caroline County - Eliminating Maximum Assessment

FOR the purpose of eliminating limitation on maximum assessment of property in Caroline County; and clarifying language.

Article 6 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
(1965 Edition, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 471 of the Public Local Laws of Caroline County being Article 6 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1965 Edition, as amended) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 6

471.

Before the powers granted by this section to the County Roads Board shall be exercised there shall first be a petition of property owners as provided in Section 468 requesting construction or improvements, public hearing upon [said] THE petition after ten days notice in a newspaper regularly published in Caroline County, approval of [said] THE petition by the County Roads Board, and the passage of an appropriate resolution,
