CHAPTER 774

(House Bill 1459)

AN ACT concerning

The General Construction Loans of 1972, 1974 and 1975

FOR the purpose of waiving the provisions of Section 10 of Chapter 179 of the Acts of 1972 and Section 10 of Chapter 289 of the Acts of 1974, said sections relating to the time by which projects contained in the General Construction Loans of 1972 and 1974 must be placed under contract, insofar as the provisions of said Sections relate to an item contained in Chapter 179 of the Acts of 1972 for the final phase construction of Matapeake Multi-Use Field Station [(and in Chapter 289 of the Acts of 1974 for
