CHAPTER 831

(House Bill 1857)

AN ACT concerning

Special Registration Plates - Veterans' Organizations

FOR the purpose of peritting special registration plates to be issued to owners of pickup trucks not exceeding three-quarter ton who are members of certain veterans' organizations; and setting forth the requirements for issuance of these plates.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws
Section 3-605 (a), (b), and (c)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 3-605 (a), (b), and (c) of Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws

3-605.

(a) Upon application to the [Commissioner] ADMINISTRATOR by the owner of any registered passenger motor vehicle ~~[[AND]]~~ OR PICKUP TRUCK NOT EXCEEDING THREE-QUARTER TON, accompanied with due proof that the owner is a bona fide member of the Department of Maryland, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, and also upon certification to the [Department of Motor Vehicles] ADMINISTRATION by the department commander of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, State of Maryland, in
