(a) For the purpose of providing funds for the design and construction of trunk sewers AND THOSE SEWERS OR PORTIONS OF SEWER LINES REQUIRED TO RELIEVE SEPTIC TANK FAILURES AND FOR WHICH NO FRONT FOOT BENEFIT CHARGES CAN BE COLLECTED AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION, sewage pumping stations and sewage disposal facilities including reimbursement to the District of Columbia or other federal authorities for any construction within the District of Columbia after January 1, 1951, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission created by Chapter 122 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1918, [be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to] MAY issue bonds of [said] THE Sanitary District from time to time, in [such] amounts [as] it
