portion of the lands within the metropolitan district, acquired for park purposes under any of the provisions of this article, (2) and/or grant privileges, permits, and/or concessions, and/or enter into contracts relating the same, with any responsible individual. partnership, or corporation, to engage in any business or enterprise on lands acquired for park purposes within the metropolitan district under any of the provisions of this article; all on terms and conditions the Commission deems advantageous to the development of the park system as a part of the plan for the physical development of plan metropolitan district an d the of District Maryland-Washington Regional within the metropolitan district. The purpose for which property is leased, and/or the privileges, permits, and/or concessions are granted, may not be inconsistent with the use of the property for park purposes. lease and/or contract executed under the authority of this section shall contain a condition, stating specifically the purpose for which the property is [lease] LEASED, and/or the privilege, permit, OI concession is granted.

The board shall designate a director to coordinate its program of recreation for Prince George's County with the Commission's park functions. The board shall employ full and part-time personmel as necessary to carry out the functions and programs provided herein. Full-time personnel shall be employed according to and shall be placed under the provisions of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission's merit system as provided in [Chapter 780 of the Laws of 1959, as amended or recodified ] THIS ARTICLE. Part-time or temporary personnel may be appointed by the board for such a period of time and at such a salary as the board may determine. The services of volunteer workers without compensation may also be accepted by the board. All personnel employed by the recreation department on the effective date of this act who are under the provisions of the Prince George's County merit system shall be employed by Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission in such capacity as will further the functions and programs provided herein, in each position classification as the board may establish, and at a pay grade not less than that occupied in the Prince George's County merit system. Employees transferring to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission pursuant to this subtitle shall be given credit for sick annual leave purposes for service under the Prince George's County merit system and for any other benefits, privileges and rights accrued while employed by Prince George's County.
