Notwithstanding the provisions of § 86 of this article, in Prince George's County between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on any day, [no] A person [shall] MAY NOT consume any alcoholic beverages on any premises open to the general public, any place of entertainment, any premises occupied regularly by a private club or organization, or any place at which setups or other component parts of mixed alcoholic drinks sold directly or indirectly, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B). Any person found consuming any alcoholic beverage [on any] WITHIN [such] THESE premises or in any [such] place during the hours specified [shall be deemed] IS guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction [thereof shall be] fined not more than [\$50.00] \$50 and not less than [\$5.00] \$5. The owner, operator, manager, waiter, server or employee of any [such] OF THESE premises or [any such place shall] PLACES MAY not knowingly permit [such] THIS consumption on those premises or in that place during the hours specified; and any owner, operator, manager, waiter, server or employee of any [such] OF THESE premises or [any such place] PLACES who shall knowingly permit [such] THIS consumption during the hours specified [shall be deemed] IS guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction [thereof shall be] IS subject to the penalties provided in § 200 of this article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That new Section 103(b) be and it is hereby added to Article 2B — Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

103.

(B) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, IF A CLASS B ON-SALE LICENSEE HAS LIVE ENTERTAINMENT WITHIN THE LICENSED PREMISES ON [[THURSDAY,]] FRIDAY, OR SATURDAY NIGHTS, THE LICENSEE MAY SELL OR SERVE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH HIS LICENSE, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. AND 3:00 A.M. OF THE FOLLOWING DAY.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.
