THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE MAY GRANT A SUM FROM THE APPROPRIATION, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000, TO LOCAL NONPROFIT AGENCIES TO ACCOMPLISH THE NECESSARY RENOVATION OF NEWLY ACQUIRED STATE-OWNED GROUP HOMES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

CHAPTER 873

(House Bill 2164)

AN ACT concerning

[[Baltimore County]] Education - Pupil Transportation

FOR the purpose of [[providing transportation in Baltimore County for certain children who live more than a certain distance from their school]] allowing any local government to provide certain transportation for certain students at its own expense; and generally relating to the requirements and financing involved in providing school transportation [[in Baltimore County]]; and providing that this Act is an emergency measure.
