Class B, in force and effect in Prince George's County, except that any restrictions against the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday appearing in § 103 and eisewhere in this article [shall] MAY not apply; and [provided further that in no event may] ANY alcoholic beverages MAY NOT be sold, served or consumed on the licensed premises on Sunday after two c'clock a.m. or before twelve o'clock noon.

(4) The board of license commissioners may issue to the holders of a beer, wine and liquor license, Class B, meeting the qualifications specified paragraph (1) of this subsection a special Sunday "on-sale" permit to allow the holder [thereof] to keep for sale and to sell at retail beer, wine and liquor on Sunday for consumption on the licensed premises between the hours of twelve o'clock noon and two o'clock a.m. the day following; providing the average daily receipts from the sale of food equals [forty percent (40%)] 40 PERCENT of the total daily receipts from the sale of food and alcoholic beverages in the establishments where it is proposed to locate [such a] THIS permit, and [such] THE ratio of food sales to the sale of alcoholic beverages has been maintained for at least six months prior to the application for [such a] THIS permit except that in the case of a newly licensed establishment the board of license commissioners may immediately authorize the issuance of a special Sunday "on-sale" permit if in the opinion of the board and upon good cause shown the newly licensed establishment meets the specifications of paragraph (1) of this subsection pertaining to the preparation, serving and sale of food and provided further that the holder of the license [thereafter] complies with the provision of this paragraph (4).

Applicants for a special Sunday "on-sale" permit shall furnish the board of license commissioners with [such] ANY proof as it [may deem] CONSIDERS necessary indicating the qualifications of the establishment to be issued [such a] THIS permit.

The holder of a special Sunday "on-sale" permit [shall be] IS subject to all other provisions of this article pertaining to beer, wine and liquor licenses, Class B, in force and effect in Prince George's County, except that any restrictions on the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday appearing in § 103 and elsewhere [shall] MAY not apply. Holders of [such a] THIS permit shall submit to the board from time to time at regular intervals to be established by the board, a statement indicating in detail the ratio of food sales to the sales alcoholic beverages. If the average daily receipts from the sale of food fail for three successive months to equal [forty percent (40%) ] 40 PERCENT of the total daily receipts from the sale of food and alcoholic beverages the board shall cancel [such] THIS permit. It [shall be] IS permissible for the licensee of a Class B, beer, wine and liquor license with a special Sunday "on-sale" permit and the licensee of a Class BH license to sell beer, wine
