confirming assessments: existing assessments: patterning the Commission procedure on procedures developed in other Maryland metropolitan areas in order to accommodate contemporary development patterns and living modes and to spread the capital costs of water and sewerage as equitably as practicable among those benefitted; permitting the Commission to require certain private systems to be dedicated; affording the Commission flexibility in the use of connection charges; permitting a more equitable distribution of the costs of the connection: providing for the acquisition existing systems; providing for the payment of certain expenses by the Ccunty Commissioners; providing certain transitory provisions and validating prior proceedings, assessments, and other charges; clarifying language; specifying a certain effective date; and relating generally to the St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission.
