

BY adding to

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
Section 192
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1968 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 192 be and it is hereby added to Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1975 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

192.

(A) IN ORDER TO PROMOTE AND PROTECT THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE PEACE OF THE COMMUNITY IN CECIL COUNTY, BY REASON OF THE PRESENCE OF MANY PERSONS ENGAGED IN THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE LAWS OF OTHER STATES, IN CECIL COUNTY ANY ~~[[LAW-ENFORCEMENT OFFICER]]~~ AGENT, EMPLOYEE, OR REPRESENTATIVE OF THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD FROM ANOTHER STATE SHALL REGISTER AT THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE EACH TIME HE ENTERS THE COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBSERVING ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES. AT TIME OF REGISTRATION THE PERSON SHALL DISCLOSE THE LOCATION OF ANY SURVEILLANCE.

[[(B) NOTICE OF THE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT SHALL BE SENT TO THE ATTORNEY GENERALS OF THE OTHER STATES.]]

(B) ANY PERSON WHO FAILS TO REGISTER AS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, OR WHO HAVING REGISTERED VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, SHALL LOSE HIS RIGHT TO REGISTER OR HIS REGISTRATION, AS THE CASE MAY BE, FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

AN ACT concerning

Bail - Remission of Forfeiture

FOR the purpose of permitting certain courts under certain circumstances to remit part of the bail
