

(1) THE PUBLIC COLLEGES ENUMERATED BELOW ARE DESIGNATED AS THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS SO AFFECTED:

- (I) BOWIE STATE COLLEGE;
- (II) COPPIN STATE COLLEGE;
- (III) FROSTBURG STATE COLLEGE;
- (IV) SALISBURY STATE COLLEGE; AND
- (V) ANY OTHER STATE COLLEGE OFFERING A FOUR-YEAR COURSE OF STUDY THAT MAY BE ESTABLISHED.

(2) THE UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE IS HEREBY DESIGNATED AS AN UPPER DIVISION ACADEMIC INSTITUTION.

(3) TOWSON STATE COLLEGE, CONTINGENT UPON ITS HAVING MET THE CRITERIA FOR NAME-CHANGE ESTABLISHED BY THE DULY CONSTITUTED STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION, IS HEREBY DESIGNATED TOWSON STATE UNIVERSITY.

[[(4) WHEREAS THE ABOVE REFERS ONLY TO DESIGNATION CHANGE, THIS ACTION MAKES NO CHANGE AS TO STRUCTURE OR GOVERNANCE OF THE BOARD OR THE INSTITUTION SO DESIGNATED.]]

(4) THIS SUBSECTION MAKES NO CHANGE IN THE STRUCTURE OR GOVERNANCE OF THE BOARD OR ANY INSTITUTIONS AFFECTED BY THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

CHAPTER 918

(Senate Bill 1125)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Choptank River Bridge

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of ~~[[\$10,000,000]]~~ [[\$2,000,000]] \$3,500,000, the proceeds to be used for the construction of a bridge over the Choptank River located at Denton in Caroline County, Maryland; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing such loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
