BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1981 ALL TELEPHONE COMPANIES DOING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE AND UTILIZING COIN PAY TELEPHONES LOCATED ON OUTDOOR SITES SHALL PROVIDE A METHOD TO PLACE CALLS TO THE OPERATOR [[WITHOUT CHARGE OR]] WITHOUT REQUIRING THE INSERTION OF ANY COINS INTO THE PAY TELEPHONE. THE COST OF PROVIDING THIS METHOD OF PLACING CALLS SHALL BE RECOGNIZED AS A REASONABLE AND NECESSARY COST OF PROVIDING TELEPHONE SERVICE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1976.

AN ACT concerning

Recordation Taxes - [[Baltimore City Rates -

FOR the purpose of [[providing amended recordation tax rates for Baltimore City; authorizing the City to revise and supersede them by ordinance; providing for collection of the recordation tax by the City; providing for payment of the tax by modes other than stamps]] clarifying legislative intent regarding recordation tax rates; and ratifying, confirming and validating authority to collect certain recordation taxes; and making this Act an emergency measure.
