(8) In Item (M) (1) (g) appearing in lines 1552 through 1558 on page 29 of the bill, the appropriation of \$100,000 for acquisition of land, being the item appearing in line 1557 entitled

"Land..... 100,000"

I construe Item (M) (1) (g) as containing two separate and distinct appropriations, one of \$100,000 for acquisition of land, and one of \$25,000 for design in connection with the renovation and restoration of the Mt. Moriah Church; and my veto applies only to the appropriation of \$100,000 for acquisition of land.

(9) Item (M) (1) (j) appearing in lines 1578 through 1588 on page 29 of the bill, entitled

"(j) Funds provided as the State's share, on a matching basis, for the restoration of the Benson-Hammond House contingent upon an equal amount matched by private funds (such as, the Northern Anne Arundel County Community) and an equal amount matched by Anne Arundel County Government (Anne Arundel County)..... 30,000"

(10) Item (M) (1) (l) appearing in lines 1596 through 1602 on page 30 of the bill, entitled

"(l) To provide funds for the purpose of restoration and renovation of the property known as Severn Crossroads Concert Theatre (Charles W. Baldwin Memorial Hall) in [[Millersville]] Crownsville (Anne Arundel County)..... 10,000"

(11) Item (M) (1) (m) appearing in lines 1604 through 1618 on page 30 of the bill, entitled

"(m) State's share of the cost of reconstruction of the Bollman Water-Main Bridge (formerly located on Lombard Street) at the Dickeyville Mill in Baltimore City contingent upon the City giving the bridge to the Maryland Historical Trust and providing the necessary right-of-ways for its use and contingent on the
