

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17, of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1467.

This bill authorizes Baltimore City to issue bonds in an amount not exceeding ten million dollars to make loans and loan guarantees for purchases of residential structures.

Senate Bill 621, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 13, 1976, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore, it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 1467.
