Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1917.

This bill authorizes the creation of a State Debt in the amount of five million dollars, the proceeds to be used for improvements to the fair ground facilities of the Maryland State Fair and Agricultural Society, Inc. at Timonium.

House Bill 1027, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 17, 1976, creates a five-year program of annual grants to the Maryland State Fair and Agricultural Society, Inc. for this same purpose.

Since the purpose of House Bill 1917 is accomplished by the enactment and signing of House Bill 1027, it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 1917.
